2019 CAPE BRETON PHILANTHROPY HALL OF FAME

The Cape Breton Regional Chamber of Commerce and the Association of Fundraising Professionals, Cape Breton Chapter have joined together to call for public nominations for inductees into the Cape Breton Business & Philanthropy Hall of Fame.

- AFP Cape Breton will receive philanthropy submissions, review and make a final decision on the recipient.
- CEO of CBRCC will represent the Chamber at the AFP meeting submission review meeting.
- AFP Cape Breton Representative to introduce the Philanthropy HOF induction portion of the evening.

Philanthropy Hall of Fame Inductee Criteria

Philanthropy Hall of Fame induction considers individuals who meet the following primary and supportive criteria:

1. Has established a philanthropic legacy in Cape Breton through the personal contribution of their treasure, time and talent to the charitable sector over a sustained period of 10 years or more.

Primary Criterion: HOF Inductee nominees must meet the following criterion.

- a. Treasure – This individual has personally made an outstanding financial contribution (one time or accumulatively) of \$100,000 or more to the charitable sector.

Supportive Criteria: Additional consideration will be given to candidates who, in support of meeting the primary criterion, exhibit one or both of the following criteria.

- b. Time – This individual has a history of being connected to the Cape Breton community through local board service and/or volunteer work
- c. Talent – This individual is a leader in the Cape Breton community and has a track-record utilizing their leadership and influence to cultivate a culture of giving amongst their peers.

**For nominees to be eligible for selection, they must not have been honoured as a recipient of the Cape Breton Business Hall of Fame in the past 5 years.*
